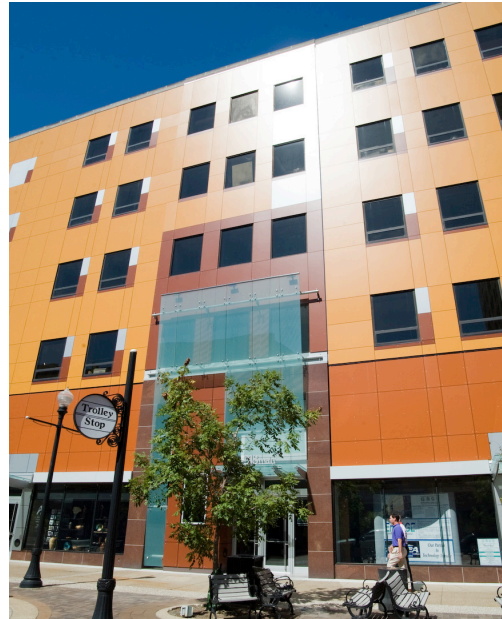

Gallery Exhibits

The Bower-Suhrheinrich foundation gallery is host to a rotating schedule of fine arts exhibits, as a part of the Arts Council's objective to make art accessible to all citizens of the Tri-State region, and to promote a vibrant artistic community.

The 2012-2013 calendar of shows included "Inspired by Women" (done in partnership with The Women's Hospital), Art by Architects & Art Educators, Art in the City, and Working Together (curated with the Evansville Museum). Young artists and the alternative artists of "The Arts Council of Doom" are also invited to utilize the gallery for shows.

Education

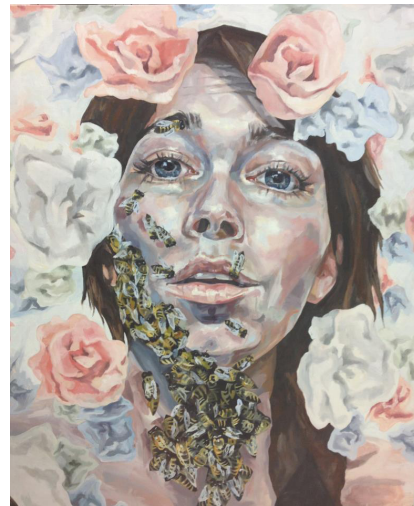
The Arts Council awards over \$360,000 in grants each year to provide arts education programming for area K-12 students. Funding in 2012 has been used for art supplies in schools, youth theater, vocal and instrumental concerts, field trips, arts competitions, and art fairs. Grants are written to public, private, parochial, and charter schools, as well as to organizations that administer arts programming as part of their mission.
